**Crossrail - Ham and Wick Sewer Diversion**

To enable the Crossrail project to be constructed, the existing Ham and Wick Sewer needs to be diverted to the west of its current alignment. We have already had discussions with the local residents association (FCARA) about this matter. The attached Information Sheet outlines the proposals.

As part of a survey in connection with the design works for the proposed sewer diversion, Cross London Rail Links Ltd, (CLRL) has appointed specialist contractors to remove vegetation from the area shown in yellow on the attached plan. Larger trees will remain in place. The proposed survey works will be undertaken wholly within the Network Rail boundary.

The removal of the vegetation will help with two surveys of the area to be undertaken. The first will be to ascertain the geology of the land. The second will be a measurement survey of the surface terrain, including a search for underground pipes and cables.

The works will be managed by Network Rail, (08457 11 41 41) and are scheduled to commence over a weekend during mid to late August over a period of 4 days. We apologise for any inconvenience to residents. The work will be carried out as quickly as possible.

No construction works will be undertaken on the Crossrail project and associated sewer diversion until Royal Assent of the Crossrail Bill is granted. It is currently anticipated that the Crossrail Bill will receive Royal Assent later in 2007 when it becomes an Act of Parliament.
